

GUIDELINES FOR TEN DAYS ASSIGNMENT TO A/BIC

1. Students in grades 6-12 may be assigned to A/BIC for 10 days **if** there are chronic offenses with appropriate documentation of previous offenses/consequences or if the infraction is very serious.
2. The assignment to A/BIC must be approved by the Director or Assistant Director of Schools.
3. Parents must provide transportation to A/BIC unless the student is certified special education and requires special transportation as stipulated in the IEP or parents of certified special education students provide adequate proof transportation cannot be provided by them.
4. The referring school **must** send the student's books and assignments for 10 days to A/BIC before the student's first day of attendance.
5. Students may be assigned to A/BIC for 10 days **one time per academic year only**. Further infractions will result in either out of school suspension or assignment to A/BIC or 45 days.
6. Parents may refuse the 10 day assignment to A/BIC and choose out of school suspension instead.
